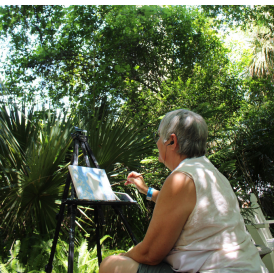
March 26, 2024: Exclusive Members-Only Spring Social
